

## Pruning management and Harvesting of Chislett Summer Navels

Agronomic advice to growers who harvest Chislett Summer Navel both early for the U.S. Export market and late for the Chis-Elite domestic and Asian export markets is to rotate the harvest of their various blocks.

This will ensure that each block in turn will be harvested early and have the chance to build up reserves for the onset of flowering.

This rotation will also facilitate post harvest pruning being undertaken in July/August rather than being delayed until after late harvest in October/November is complete.
